Lexmark Multifunction Devices

Centralized scanning processes take 24 to 72 hours before files are available to clinical staff. This delay can be critical, especially in the ER, where patients are usually admitted and released the same day. Many times with centralized scanning, there are only a limited number of scanners available and only within a few departments in the healthcare facility. With the integrated network solution, Lexmark multifunction devices (MFD) can be located at nursing stations and other key sites throughout the facility. Critical paper document availability can be cut from days to minutes.

This solution integrates network connected Lexmark multifunction devices (MFD) as an alternative to direct attached scanners, while providing immediate online document availability.

Benefits of Network Attached Scanners

With a network attached solution, you can replace existing stand-alone scanners for image acquisition, as well as the replacement of the printer, copier and fax devices. The Lexmark multifunction printers have the capability of printing, copying, faxing and scanning – saving time spent travelling to a centralized facility.

Simple Scanning Process

The intuitive color touchscreen on the Lexmark multifunction devices make scanning easy. Through the use of customized icons, the user only has to follow these steps to complete the document scanning process:

- User logs into Cerner *PowerChart*® then selects a patient, clicks on the clinical notes tab
- User clicks “scan/import” icon on the toolbar
- User clicks “scan”
- User inserts the document to scan into the MFD tray and presses his/her icon (it features the photo of the user) on the display
- Once scanned, the multifunction device scanned document appears in the viewer
- The document appears with the clinical notes below

Once the documents are scanned, they are stored in *Cerner Millennium*® and can now be viewed from any location, including a nursing station, an off-site doctor's office or the facility's business office.
